Dear Guest,

We are delighted to welcome you to our establishment.

Since our creation, we have placed environmental respect at the heart of what we do. For us, for you, and for future generations, we do everything we can to minimize the impact of our activity on the environment.

WE RAISE AWARENESS AMONG OUR TEAMS AND OUR GUESTS:

- Our environmental manager has completed specific training on sustainable tourism, environmental preservation, and CSR issues;
- Our teams are trained in eco-friendly practices to apply in their daily tasks;
- We select our service providers and suppliers based on their sustainable and social commitments;
- We provide our guests with information booklets, brochures, and displays about the animal and plant species found in the surrounding area;
- We offer numerous alternatives to limit car travel: bike rental, shuttles, public transport, and carpooling options.

WE SAVE WATER AND ENERGY:

- We have installed water savers/pressure reducers on taps and showers to avoid depleting the resource;
- We read our water and electricity meters every month to better manage our consumption;
- All our lighting is LED, which saves energy while providing the same level of comfort for our guests;
- We have installed motion detectors/timers in common areas and corridors to limit energy waste;
- We are committed to the development of renewable energy (we have signed a green energy supply contract).

WE REDUCE AND SORT WASTE:

- We have set up a selective sorting point located in the breakfast room;
- We mainly work with bulk or large-format products to limit unnecessary packaging;
- We only offer guest amenities upon request, in order to reduce packaging waste;
- We have put up signage to help our guests sort waste in line with local regulations;
- We do not offer any disposable tableware.

WE CARE ABOUT OUR GUESTS' WELL-BEING:

- In our grocery corner, you will find many products from our region sourced directly from local producers;
- We cook with seasonal, local products and can accommodate certain specific diets;
- Our restaurant menus include organic and/or fair-trade products;
- All products used to clean our rooms and rental units are eco-labelled, offering better air quality and fewer health risks;
- For the well-being of our teams and yours, we have banned bleach, which is irritating to the respiratory tract and toxic to aquatic life;
- Our establishment is entirely non-smoking;
- We have chosen certified bed linen (organic cotton) for our guests, and certified organic cotton uniforms for our teams.
